To provide reassurance to all customers, TLE have created a six point strategy on how we are making our Camps a safe place.

Space and Social Distancing

Venue will be supervised and marked out in line with government guidance and group sizes are reduced in designated bubbles, one deliverer will remain with a bubble all week.

Hygiene and Cleanliness

Hand washing stations are available and a hygiene supervisor will be present all day cleaning all equipment and facilities continuously. Reduced opening hours (8:30am–3pm) to give us time for a daily deep clean

Contact Free Sign In/Out

Booking made and paid for online. Our camp leader will sign your child in and out reducing the requirement for you to have to sign them in. Accident forms will be sent via e-mail reducing contact.

Staff Training

All team members have received the relevant training and support to ensure safe practice and risk reduction.

Safe Activities

Equipment is cleaned before and after use with timetables amended to ensure only non-contact activities are delivered. Team members have been issued with a bank of socially distanced activity ideas.

Policies and Procedures

We have produced an operating guidance and risk assessment which will be shared with parents via our website. Changes to procedures include no breakfast or drink provision.
